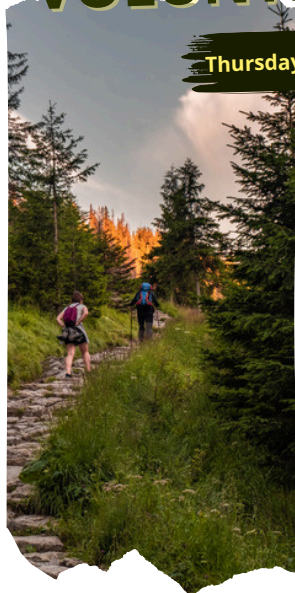

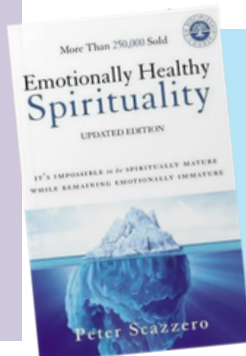

Present: Doug Wagner, Neil Fritz, Pastor Mike, Randy Inboden, and John Gabbard

Justin was with us for the beginning of our meeting.

We spent time in prayer over many items.

We discussed follow up from the 2nd meeting Neil and Justin had with a staff person. We came to a consensus on a path forward. Justin and another Elder will meet with the staff person within the next two weeks. Justin stepped out to the Deacons meeting after this discussion. Pastor Mike and Randy shared this with the Deacons.

Pastor Mike shared and asked for wisdom as to how to proceed with something pertaining to staff. Pastor Mike will move forward with the consensus of the Elders and address the staff item.

We reviewed a letter that came in from a member as part of the nomination process for Elders and Deacons. We appreciated the letter and through discussion discerned the person could still serve. Pastor Mike and Randy discussed this with the Deacons. The Deacons agreed in their discussion about the letter as well that the person could still serve.

Pastor Mike shared that Herb Huff is willing to step into the role of Missions Chair. The Elders agreed unanimously as did the Deacons to this. Neil Fritz will work with Herb to get him acclimated.

Pastor Mike reminded them of the upcoming Family Meeting on Wednesday, May 20th @ 6:30pm.

Pastor Mike offered some ideas for updates to his job description. He asked the Elders to review them and we can discuss them at our next meeting in June. The Elders agreed.

- Lynn reported that the leaks at the gas well have been repaired. Ask Kaitlin to request a document of service, a work order, or invoice that shows the work was completed, and what all was done so we have it for our records.
