Moreover, there is a lot of work and people power that goes into two services. So, for the time being starting this Sunday, we will have one service for those who choose to attend in person. Lisa will continue to have children's classes. Ben will continue to have high school after church and junior high virtual during the week.

The rows will be relabeled for those who come to service. This will allow us continue to maintain physical distance. Be sure to sit in the appropriate row when you attend. Masks will continue to be required for all who attend for the safety of all who attend.

Here is an update on what the Deacons and Elders have been working on/deciding:

The back corner of the building has been repaired. A new storm drain has been put in to keep all the salt and weather from coming against the back of the building. So far it is working wonderfully. The parking lot has been completed. The Deacons are looking to move forward with constructing an air lock at the Main entrance.

We are currently planning on having two Christmas Eve services this year as normal. The Contemporary at 5pm and the Traditional at 7pm. We will keep you updated if this changes. Both services will be streamed live for those who remain at home.
